## for Finding a Budget for Captioning

Finding a budget for captioning doesn't have to be a challenge. There are many creative solutions to ensure you can get your videos captioned.



**Pre-pay for the next year with leftover funds at the end of a fiscal year**

Add leftover funds to a your captioning account as credit for next year.

**Did you know?** 46% of institutions use a third party to create captions for online courses.

**Create a captioning grant from student fees (part of tuition)**

Add a small fee within the tuition fee solely allocated for captioning videos.

**Did you know?** 71% of students without hearing difficulties use captions at least some of the time.



**Find line items in other budgets that can be used for captioning**

Departments allocate funds for services and supplies. Captioning may not be specifically named, but it certainly fits into the needs of these budgets!

**Did you know?** 87% of institutions add closed captions to at least some videos.
